REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 - Organisation

The competition, which has international status, shall be run in accordance with the International Sporting Code and its appendices, the FIA official Bulletins, the General Prescriptions applicable to all FIA Championships, Challenges, Trophies & Cups and to their qualifying competitions run on Circuits, the Sporting Regulations of the FIA Lurani Trophy for Formula Junior Cars ("LTFJ") and these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 4 – Insurances

In compliance with the legal prescriptions, the Organiser has contracted one or several insurance(s) guaranteeing the following risk(s):

- Third Party Civil Liability with a value of Corporal Damages -€ 48.560.000,00 per accident and 6.070.000,00 per injured
- Material Damages € 9.760.000,00 per Accident and 1.220.000,00 per injured

Article 5 - Protests and Appeals

Amount of the protest fee: € 500€

Amount of the international appeal fee (FIA): €3,000.

All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code. All protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards, together with the required protest fee.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit. The deposit is based on the decision of the stewards for the present case.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Articles 15.1 to 15.4 of the Code and also as set out in the Rules of the International Court of Appeal.
