Article 5 – Protests and Appeals

The protest fee is €1,000.
The international appeal fee (FIA) is €6,000 for World RX and €3,000 for Euro RX.
Fee for the right of review deposit is € 2,000, (according to Art. 14.4.3 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code).

All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code. All protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the Competition, together with the required protest fee.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Article 15 of the Code and as set out in the Rules of the International Court of Appeal.

Article 6 – Event supplementary provisions

- Advertisement restrictions by law in the country: (if any): No political, religious, or abusive advertising. Advertising of tobacco or tobacco products is forbidden.
