### **Car weight**

#### **Art 13.4 Sporting Regulations of the FIA World Rallycross Championship**

As provided for in Article 13.4 of the Championship Sporting Regulations the weight of the Driver will also be checked at the end of each World RX Final this weekend.

*“... The weight of cars and Drivers may be checked separately at the end of the Competition... subject to a controlled and certified scale being located in the podium Parc Fermé on which the Drivers are weighed when they get out of their cars. The car will then be checked in the weighing area at final scrutineering and the weights will be combined.”*
