ART. 2 – ORGANIZATION

2.1 – Demoporto – Clube de Desportos Motorizados do Porto, holder of licence 71 issued by FPAK, is organising a national motorsport event, called the Boticas Hill Climb, from September 4th to 6th, 2026, starting at the EM 530 roundabout and ending after the last houses on CM 1038.

2.1.1 – This Event will be contested according to the terms stipulated in Article 2.3 of the International Sporting Code, consequently allowing the participation of drivers holding sporting licences issued by an ASN other than the FPAK, however, the exception in the same article of the ISC applies, which expressly states:

“A national competition/event may also, at the discretion of the ASN that authorises it, admit the participation of licences from other ASN. In this case, when said competition/event is part of a national championship or series, competitors holding sports licences issued by any other ASN (different from that of the country where the competition/event is organised) will not be eligible to score points in the ranking of national championships or series.”

Due to the existing agreement between FPAK and RFEDA, the aforementioned restriction does not apply to participating drivers who hold Sporting licences issued by the Royal Spanish Automobile Federation (RFEDA). Furthermore, and in accordance with the terms defined in the same article of the ISC, it is hereby informed that: The categories of vehicles allowed to participate in this race/event are the same as those listed in the race/event's specific regulations.

Article 3 – General Provisions

3.1 –This RACE / EVENT will be held in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) and its annexes, the General Regulations for Motorsport and Karting 2026 (PGAK), the Specific Regulations for Hill Climb 2026 (PEM), the Regulations of the Portuguese Hill Climb Championship 2026 and these Regulations, which all competitors, by the simple fact of their registration, undertake to respect.

3.2 –This event will count towards the 2026 Portuguese Hill Climb Championships and Cups.

Article 5 – Vehicles and Drivers Allowed

5.1 - Vehicles

5.1.1- For CPM / CPCM / CPLM / TPM / TPCM / TPKM / TPMM and FJTM, the vehicles will be in accordance with what is defined in Article 2 of the technical regulations of the 2026 Portuguese Hill Climb Championships and Cups.

5.2 – Approved Drivers

5.2.1 – The rules for CPM / CPCM / CPLM / TPM / TPCM / TPKM / TPMM and FJTM will be in accordance with what is defined in Article 4 of the Sports Regulations of the Portuguese Hill Climb Championships and Cups 2026.

Article 6 – ENTRIES

6.1 – Entries will be accepted in accordance with Articles 3.8 to 3.20 of the ISC from the date of publication of this Supplementary Regulations.

6.2 Entries location: FPAK Portal

6.2.1 Entries Form - It will only be accepted by the organiser if it is fully completed and accompanied by proof of payment.

6.3 – Deadline for submitting the registration form –26/08/2026 – 23:00

6.4 –Double entries (1 driver for 2 cars or 1 car for 2 drivers) are not allowed.

Article 7 – Registration Fees – Competition/Event Insurance

7.1 –The registration fee for each category (with the mandatory advertising proposed by the organiser) will be subject to VAT at the current rate, as well as insurance according to the mandatory FPAK Civil Liability Insurance tariff in effect for the current year. These amounts must be paid together with the registration fee.

7.4 – DESCRIPTION OF EVENT INSURANCE COVERAGE

7.4.1 -The insurance premium does not include the insurance for the car and competitor's civil liability for any accidents that may occur during the event.

Article 8 – ADVERTISING

8.1 –The mandatory advertising for Race/Event numbers is as follows:

8.2 –All competitors are required to display the promoter's mandatory advertising on their vehicles, in the designated locations, as defined in Appendix II and III of the 2026 Portuguese Hill Climb Championship and Cup sporting regulations.

Art.9 – CPM/CPCM/CPLM/TPM/TPCM/TPKM/TPMM/FJTM

9.1 – Practice sessions will be conducted in accordance with Article 21.4 of the PEM.

9.2 The race/event will be contested over three climbs, with the sum of the times achieved on the two best climbs counting towards the overall race/event classification.
All drivers are required to complete at least two event runs.

9.3 – Timing is performed using photoelectric cells with a minimum accuracy of 1/1000 of a second.

Article 10 – PARK FERMÉ

10.1 After the final climb of the first day, the vehicles will remain in Park Fermé for a minimum of 30 minutes. After crossing the finish line, all drivers must drive their vehicles directly to the Park Fermé, located at the end of the Boticas Hillclimb in Largo do Monte da Boticas, following the instructions provided by the Track Marshals.

10.2 At the end of their RACE / EVENT, or at the end of the three race / event runs, if they are classified, all Drivers must drive their vehicles directly to the Parc Fermé, which is located at the end of the Boticas Hillclimb in Largo do Monte da Boticas, following the instructions that will be given to them by the Track Marshals.

Article 11 – ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS AND SCRUTINEERING

11.1 –Administrative Checks and scrutineering will be carried out in accordance with the Event Programme.

11.2 –Intermediate vehicle weighing checks will be carried out at the end of the course, in the finish area - at the end of the hill climb, and drivers will be informed upon arrival.

11.3 -The final scrutineering will be carried out at the Boticas Municipal Council warehouse. Drivers will be informed upon entering the Parc Fermé at the end of the race/event if their vehicle has been designated for scrutineering, and in that case, they must follow the instructions given to them by the race/event officials.

Article 12 – Anti-doping and anti-alcohol control

According to Articles 18 and 19 of the PGAK, anti-doping and anti-alcohol controls will be carried out at HQ.

Article 13 – Complaints – Right of Review – Appeals
