1.1. Preamble

The Competition shall be run in accordance with the International Sporting Code and its appendices, the FIA official Bulletins, the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Rallycross Championships the WADA/NADA Codes and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations Part 1 and Part 2, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins.

These Supplementary Regulations, Part 1 and the subsequently published Part 2, together constitute the binding Supplementary Regulations for the event. The binding text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

6. ADVERTISING

Competitors taking part in International Competitions are not allowed to affix to their Automobiles advertising that is political or religious in nature or that is prejudicial to the interests of the FIA.

Advertisement for alcohol, tobacco, games, lotteries and pornography is restricted by national law.

7. TYRES (Art. 9 of the Euro RX Championship Regulations)

The Tyres must be registered during scrutineering. See Art. 3. Program.

Only tyres from Hoosier Tire, supplied by Service Partner APR with the original tread pattern may be used. No additional cutting is allowed.

RX1 and RX3 (48101RX / 48106WET)

Further information about adding or reducing the number of newly registered tyres or previously registered tyres may be defined in the Supplementary Regulations part 2.

8. FUEL

Competitors must use fuel which complies with Appendix J Art. 266. B.1 and 266.B.3.2. Please refer to FIA Euro RX Championship Regulations Art 17.1

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING

9.3. Documents to be presented

- International competitors' licence
- Drivers' international competition licence
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Drivers' passport or identity card
- Driver declaration and Undertakings form duly signed by the Driver (submitted online)
- Entry Form duly signed by the Competitor and the Driver

The entry form must be signed by both parties and presented in printed format by the representative of the team during the Administrative Checks.

All the original documents listed above must be brought to the Administrative Checks in case they need to be visually inspected. In case required a printed and unsigned original entry form can be provided at the Administrative Checks by the organiser for signing.

10. SCRUTINEERING

10.1. Scrutineering, venue and time

Location: Paddock or scrutineering area as defined in Supplementary regulations part 2 or in a Bulletin.

Time: See program (SR Art. 3). The detailed scrutineering and tyre registration schedule will be published in Supplementary Regulations Part 2.

10.2. Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars complete certified homologation or documents for the cars not homologated with the FIA but eligible in RX1 / RX3 / RX4 and RX5
- Roll cage original certificate (if any)
- Catalyser certificate
- Racing net installation form

11. OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

11.1. Drivers' briefing:

Location: Main Building, 2nd Floor

Time: See program (SR Art. 3)

Any information communicated during the briefing that may impact timing or regulations shall be confirmed by means of an official written bulletin.

11.2. Engineering Personnel

Euro RX team "engineering personnel" is allowed to work on the cars from Thursday 09:00 to Sunday 23:59.

11.3. Practice

Since there will be no Official Practice, but only Free Practice 1 and Free Practice 2 as outlined in the Euro RX Championship Regulations Article 6.2, the mandatory minimum number of laps required under Article 32 must be completed during either of the free practice sessions.

11.4. Finish

Should the end-of-race signal be inadvertently delayed, the final classification shall be determined based on the positions recorded at the moment the race distance was originally scheduled to be completed.

11.5. Media Zones

The top three drivers from all categories must be available for media interviews for a minimum of 10 minutes or until they are given permission to leave by the FIA Media Delegate.

The media zone will be operational as follows after the final heat or session of each day. The media zone will be located in the media centre.

Access to the media zone is restricted to the following:

- Accredited media or team media personnel holding a media pass.
- Team principals or team representatives, who are, in view of the FIA Media Delegate, performing media duties.
- Holders of an FIA RX all access pass.

No other personnel will be allowed in the media zone unless authorized by the FIA Media Delegate and holding the correct pass and approved access.

12. PRIZES AND AWARDS

Per competition, trophies and cash prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 Drivers

- RX1 Category (respectively €1,100, €660, €440)
- RX3 Category (respectively €550, €440, €330)
- RX4 Category (respectively €440, €330, €220)
- RX5 Category (respectively €330, €220, €110)

13. FINAL CHECKS / PROTESTS / APPEALS / FINES

13.1. Final Checks

Location: Paddock or scrutineering bay as defined in Supplementary regulations part 2 or in a Bulletin

Time: Immediately after the Final

13.2. Protests and petitions of review

All protests must be lodged in accordance with Article 13 of the Code. All protests must be made in writing and handed to the chair of the panel of the Stewards. In the absence of the chair of the panel of the Stewards, such protests shall be delivered to one of the other Stewards, or in their absence, to the Race Director or assistant if such exists, or the Clerk of the Course or assistant if such exists, together with the required protest deposit or the prove to the payment of such deposit to FIA.

The protest or petition of review deposit is €1,000.

13.3. APPEALS

Competitors have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.

The appeal fee and the appeal deposit is laid down in Article 14.1.2 of the of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.

13.4. FINES

In accordance with Article 12.8 FIA International Sporting Code, the payment of the fines must be done online, within 48 hours of their notification, at the following address: <https://fiafines.fia.com> Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.
