

# APPENDIX 1 - COVID-19 GUIDELINES

*RMCIT 2020 will take place in Portimão, Portugal, from Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December to Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2020.*

## 1. EVENT BEHIND CLOSED DOORS:

- RMCIT 2020 will be behind closed doors.

## 2. NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIMITED ON-SITE:

- RMCIT 2020 will take place with a restricted number of people on-site.
- Each driver is authorized to enter the paddock with **2 attendees** maximum.
- Attendees include everybody: Entrant, Guardian, Team Manager, Mechanic, Truck Driver, Engineer, Motorist, Staff Team, Professional, Coach, Parents, Family, Friends, etc.

## 3. ONLINE ATTENDEES REGISTRATION:

- Each driver has to register mandatory online these 2 people maximum.

## 4. RESPECT OF GUIDELINES:

- Driver is responsible for these 2 attendees.
- In case of no respect of the RMCIT & local health rules by the drivers or these attendees, the drivers will receive a penalty (fine, time penalty, position penalty or exclusion of the event).

## 5. FACE MASK WEARING:

- The face mask wearing is compulsory all-over the site and inside the team tents.
- Drivers are allowed to wear their helmet instead of their face mask at the start servicing park, pre-grid, repair area and park finish.

## 6. MINIMUM DISTANCE:

- Social distancing of 2 meters must be respected at all times.

## 7. GROUP OF PEOPLE:

- Groups with more than 5 people are forbidden if they don't belong to the same family.

## 8. PADDOCK ACCESS:

- To be authorized to enter the paddock, you must:
  - Be a driver registered at the RMCIT 2020 or be registered online as attendee (attendees maximum per driver).
  - Provide a COVID-19 PCR test with a negative result for everybody (drivers + attendees) to get access to the paddock. This test cannot be older than 96 hours.

## 9. PADDOCK ACCREDITATION PROCESS:

- a) Go to the Paddock Accreditation Office.
- b) If you are a driver: Declare your racing number.

If you are an attendee: Declare the racing number of your responsible driver who has registered you.

- c) Give the copy of your passport or your identity card.
- d) Give the copy of your COVID-19 test not older than 96 hours.
- e) If you are registered as driver or attendee and your COVID-19 test is negative and not older than 96 hours, you will get a paddock access wristband.

You will NOT be authorized to enter the paddock if:

- You are an attendee not registered online (deadline Sunday 08th November 2020 at 23:59 CET).
- You don't have a PCR COVID-19 test.
- Your PCR COVID-19 test is older than 96 hours.
- Your PCR COVID-19 test is positive.

## 10. PADDOCK ENTRANCE MANAGEMENT:

- A paddock entrance management system will be installed at the entrance of the paddock.

This system will allow to check:

- The entries by facial recognition\*.
- The frontal temperature of each person.
- The wearing mask at the entrance.

## 11. SIGNBOARDS ON-SITE:

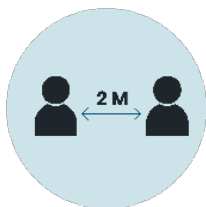
- The following signboards will be installed on-site with the following meanings:

## **12. BRIEFING:**

- As any form of gathering is prohibited, the briefing will be done via a video link.
- It is the responsibility of the drivers and entrants to watch carefully the video of the briefing.
- A WhatsApp number will be provided for any drivers who wish to ask any questions to the race director about anything to do with the briefing.

## **13. TRACK FEE OFFICE:**

- Track Fee Office will be located in the left building of the track.
- Only one person per driver is authorized to come to purchase the track fee.
- Drivers and legal guardians for underage must respect the Track Fee corridor and marks on the ground for social distance.
- Washing hands with hand sanitizer gel will be mandatory at the Track Fee Office.

## **14. SPORTING CHECKS:**

- Sporting Checks Office will be located in the left building of the track.
- Sporting Checks will be done by class following the timetable.
- Only drivers and legal guardians for underage are authorized to do the Sporting Checks.
- Drivers and legal guardians for underage must respect the Sporting Check corridor and marks on the ground for social distance.
- Washing hands with hand sanitizer gel will be mandatory at the Sporting Checks Office.

## **15. TYRES DISTRIBUTION:**

- Tyres Distribution will be located in the right building of the track.
- Tyres Distribution will be done by class following the timetable.
- Only drivers or mechanics are authorized to go to the Tyres Distribution.
- Drivers mechanic must respect the Tyres Distribution corridor and marks on the ground for social distance.

## **16. SCRUTINEERING:**

- Scrutineering will be located in the right building of the track.
- Scrutineering will be done by class following the timetable.
- Only driver and mechanics are authorized to do the Scrutineering.
- Drivers and mechanics must respect the Scrutineering corridor and marks on the ground for social distance.

## **17. START SERVICING PARK ACCESS:**

- Only drivers and mechanics are authorized to go to the Start Servicing Park.
- Drivers and mechanics must respect the Start Servicing Park corridor.
- Mechanics must wear the mechanic badge.

## **18. PODIUMS:**

- Podiums ceremonies will be done at the end of the event following the timetable.
- Drivers must wear a face mask.
- Any contacts between drivers on the podium have to be avoided.
